## Signs Show Folks Like Lottery



You don't have to look too hard to see the signs that North Carolinians like their lottery.

- **Sales are up.** We averaged \$5.4 million in ticket sales a day last year. People are voting for the lottery with their dollars.
- **More businesses want to sell lottery tickets.** We recorded the highest number of retail partners, 6,901. That's 127 more from the year before.
- **Membership in our Lucke-Zone is climbing.** We now have more than 600,000 members, and we add more each month. Players buy tickets from you and then go to the Lucke-Zone to get news, ask questions and enter second-chance drawings.
- **The number of stores with lottery tickets sales of \$1 million or more is growing.** Last year, we had our first store to exceed \$3 million in sales, five exceeded \$2 million in sales and 79 exceeded \$1 million in sales.

Since we ended our 9th full fiscal year on June 30, I'd like to share some of the financial highlights of the year. We had our 9th year of consecutively growing both sales and earnings. Our biggest success was in our instant games. We recorded \$1.29 billion in instant ticket sales, up 10.6 percent from the year before. Your lottery also:

- Recorded highest sales ever, \$1.97 billion. Sales were up, 5.8 percent.
- Earned for the second time more than half a billion dollars for education, \$521 million. Profits for education were up 3.8 percent.
- Received for 9th year in a row a clean review during its annual independent financial audit.
- Provided \$1 million to N.C. Problem Gambling Program.

Success like this doesn't come without hard work. As our sales go up, so do your commissions. We paid out a total of \$137 million, \$9 million more than the year before.

Thank you for helping us raise money for education and helping to make North Carolina better.



# Net Sales FY 2015




## Best Selling Scratch-Off Games



## Money raised for education helps make North Carolina better

For the 9th year in a row, the N.C. Education Lottery set a new record for how much it raised in a year for education, raising \$521 million. That's an increase of 3.8 percent from the year before.

Final transfers of revenues to the state in June brought the lottery's total contribution since inception to more than \$3.9 billion.

Legislators decide how the lottery dollars are used. Last year, lottery proceeds were used to:

- Help pay salaries of teachers and teacher assistants.
- Help counties with construction and repair of schools.
- Help North Carolina students pay the cost of going to a state university or community college.
- Help "at-risk" four-year-olds attend an academic preschool in the N.C. Pre-K Program.

The lottery dollars are making a difference for education in every county in North Carolina.

Raising more money each year than the year before is a big challenge. We hope to raise \$529 million this year.

## Responsible Gaming in North Carolina

In the North Carolina Education Lottery's efforts to ensure our players continue to play responsibly, we have several tools that can be utilized by our retailers.



**Retailer Responsible Gaming Training:** It is our hope to train every NCEL retailer in Responsible Gaming. A retailer who is renewing a lottery license and new retailers will go through a web-based responsible gaming training. Upon completion the retailer will receive a "Responsible Gaming Approved" stamp to be added to the store's license to sell.



**Gambling Helpline Button on the Lottery Terminal:** This resource is meant to be utilized if you think a player may have a gambling problem. You can discreetly print this piece of paper that looks like a ticket in order to provide a gentle reminder about the gambling helpline offered in North Carolina.



**N.C. Problem Gambling Helpline:** Problem gamblers and their loved ones can receive help 24 hours a day by calling 877-718-5543, texting morethanagamenc to 53342 (normal text messaging fees may apply) or by live web chat at [www.morethanagamenc.com](http://www.morethanagamenc.com).



**"What Will You Lose" pamphlets:** These pamphlets can be found in every play center and directs players with a problem to utilize the N.C. Problem Gambling Helpline and website.

## Your customers won \$1 MILLION OR MORE 55 times last year!

When your customers come in the store to play the lottery, they hope to win a big prize one day. So how many times did that happen last year?

Fifty-five times. Yes. That's how many times between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015 that someone walked into lottery headquarters and collected a prize that ranged from \$1 million to our biggest prize of the year, a \$188 million share of a Powerball jackpot.

### WHAT GAMES PRODUCED THOSE WINS?

- ★ 41 of those winners won with a scratch-off ticket.
- ★ 12 won with a Powerball ticket.
- ★ 1 won with a Mega Millions ticket.
- ★ 1 won in our special drawing for the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB™ draw game.

Where did those big winners come from? If you look across the state, the new lottery millionaires came from 36 of North Carolina's 100 counties and two were out-of-state visitors.

Who were they? The million dollar winners we met represented a cross-section of North Carolinians. We met a construction worker, an art teacher, retirees, small business owners, homemakers, painters, a sales rep, a handyman, a plumber, Navy and Army veterans, bank employees, carpenters, an engineer, and an insurance agent.

Some said they planned to buy a new home or pay off the mortgage. Some said they would buy a new car or new boat. Some had travel plans, to Disney, to Hawaii, to Alaska. Some planned to save for retirement or for a child or grandchild's education. One planned to buy a rescue dog. A couple said the winnings would help with a wedding or a honeymoon they never got to take. Many had plans to help their family or a cause important in their lives.



### DID YOU KNOW?

If you ever get questions about lottery prizes, here's a good fact to know: In all, the lottery awarded \$1.2 billion in prizes, large and small, last year. That averages out to about \$3.4 million a day.

We hope to meet even more million dollar winners this year. You sell the tickets. We'll keep handing out the big prizes.

# Who Do I Call?!

## Reporting Internal Theft

As a retailer, you know the challenges that you face when it comes to protecting your store inventory from loss. When incidents of theft occur, either through robbery, burglary or internal theft, the impact on your operations can be dramatic. Often the losses exceed the mere cost of the items and can include things like repairs to your facility, loss of business, or the costs of hiring and training a new employee.



We understand that your time is valuable and that you may not have the expertise in conducting a theft investigation...

so, where do you turn and who do you call for help when you suspect or catch one of your employees stealing lottery tickets?



First, call the NCEL Security Department (888-732-6235).



Our team of highly trained professionals will be able to take your report and immediately block the stolen tickets so that they cannot be cashed.



An NCEL Investigator will then be assigned to the case to work closely with you to conduct a thorough investigation and coordinate prosecution with your local law enforcement agency.



Our goals in these cases are to reduce the time that you have to spend investigating the incident, identify the source of your loss and then build an air-tight case for court that not only ends in a successful prosecution (if prosecution is your preference), but also positions you to receive compensation for the loss through court-ordered restitution.

For example, in one incident a retailer notified the NCEL Security Department that they were having difficulty reconciling ticket inventory and suspected a dishonest employee at work. After visiting with the retailer and reviewing inventory tracking sheets, employee schedules and store video, it was determined that a single employee was responsible for thousands of dollars in stolen lottery tickets. Our investigator conducted interviews, gathered all of the evidence, met with local law enforcement and led the case to a successful prosecution...which included full restitution back to the retailer!

## Check ID!

North Carolina General Statute 18C-131(d) prohibits the sale of lottery tickets to a person under 18 years of age.

Always check North Carolina driver's licenses and identification cards for the red border around the photo. If the border is present, examine the ID and make sure that they are 18 years of age.

Proper checking of ID is each retailer's responsibility, so please be sure that all of your store's personnel are aware of this requirement.

To assist with this, the legal sell-to age date is now located at the top of the terminal screen.
