Today, Alice Garland, NCEL deputy executive director, congratulated Howell and gave him the keys during a celebratory event at New Dixie #21 on 179 Old Farm Rd in Roanoke Rapids where Howell had purchased his winning ticket.

Mustang Fever is a \$5 instant scratch-off ticket that not only features a total of six prizes of a 2010 Ford Mustang V6 convertible, but it also had a total of six top prizes of \$100,000! There are two of those remaining as of this morning.
