## Unclaimed Powerball ticket worth \$200,000 about to expire

**RALEIGH** – Powerball players in North Carolina, especially those in the Sanford area, should double-check any tickets they have to see if they are the winner of an unclaimed \$200,000 prize. The ticket was purchased for the March 20, 2010 Powerball drawing and will expire on Thursday, Sept. 16.

The ticket was purchased at the Kangaroo Express, located at 14591 N.C. 27 West in Sanford. It matched five white balls in the drawing. The five white balls for that drawing were:

**9 – 36 – 39 – 44 – 45**

To claim the \$200,000 prize, the ticket must be presented at N.C. Education Lottery headquarters in Raleigh by 5 p.m. on Sept. 16.
